1. Establish Representative Membership

6. Organize systematic ongoing professional development
7. Determine student involvement

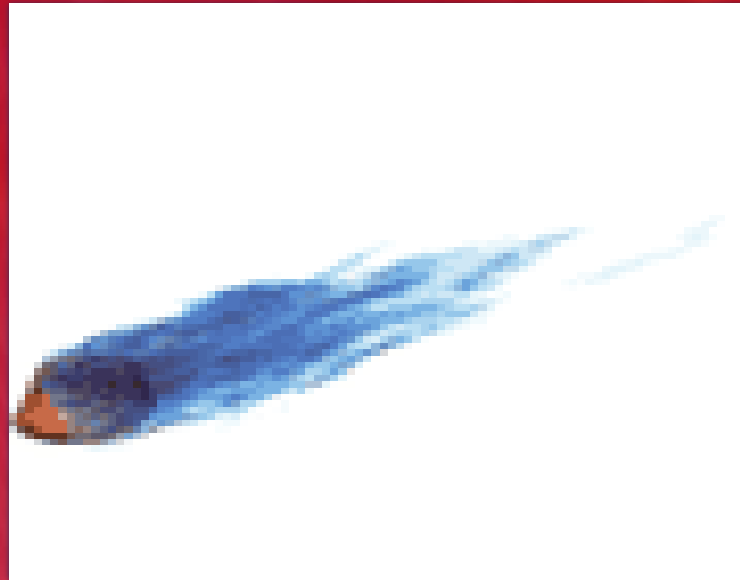
