

Sample High School
Classroom Consequences

Below are suggestions for classroom consequences. Teachers should choose an appropriate consequence for the behavior. Documentation of the incident and the consequence is required beginning with the second offense.

First Offense

Proximity Control
Nonverbal cue to correct behavior
Warning (Verbal or Written) / Behavior Correction

*Second Offense**

Contact parents
Last to leave room
Seat change
Lose participation points
Time with teacher
Speak to student after class
Write apology

*Remember to write a Minor Referral and contact parents

*Third Offense**

Contact parents
Last to leave room
Seat change
Lose participation points
Time with teacher
Speak to student after class
Write apology

*Remember to write a Minor Referral and contact parents

Fourth Offense

Send the student to the Dean of Students:

1. Call to inform of the problem and to expect the student
2. Write a major referral when time permits (with explanation)
3. Contact parents as soon as possible about the incident

Note: If the Dean is unavailable, check with the Assistant Principal or Principal
