### **Description:**

**The development of classroom management procedures based on the values and behavioral expectations established for the whole school environment is central to the provision of Tier I PBIS. Research and practice have demonstrated that many of the same approaches used to establish behavioral expectations in non-classroom settings can and should be used by teachers in their classrooms. In addition, classrooms provide the primary setting for teaching social behavior, and supporting each student's sense of belonging and safety. This workshop will provide attendees with the following:**

- 1.        An understanding of how classroom management fits into Tier I schoolwide behavioral supports.**
- 2.        The steps involved in developing a comprehensive classroom management plan based on the PBIS model.**
- 3.        Practice using the "Classroom Management Checklist and Planning Document" to develop and monitor the effectiveness of your classroom management plan.**
- 4.        Specific strategies for creating an environment in which all students feel safe and included.**
- 5.        A process for linking classroom-based behavioral data to the schoolwide data system.**
