Forgery/Theft	Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property or has signed a person's name without the person's permission	Forged notes from parents, doctors, teacher, etc., plagiarism, stealing, hiding/purchasing stolen property, aiding someone in stealing, pretending to be another student's parent over the phone	Telling untruths/wrongful accusations, copying, obtaining questions/answers to school assignments/tests
